Our PHSR faculty members focus their research on comparative effectiveness and patient-centered outcomes research (CER/PCOR), policy, law, pharmacoepidemiology, social/behavioral science, and pharmacoconomics. Candidates should have a health services research background, with particular emphasis on epidemiology and/or CER/PCOR.
