serve as course coordinator and instructor for suitable courses for undergraduate, PharmD and graduate students. An initial assignment is in teaching and supervising several hands-on labs in PHC 521, Pharmaceutical Analysis. Active engagement in mentoring graduate students is an expectation.

- Service assignments are made by the Chair and Division Head and involve serving on departmental, school and university committees, including serving as departmental seminar chair. The expectation is that you will contribute to the scientific community through service on scientific review boards, journal advisory boards, and active participation with scientific/professional organizations, as time permits.
- Research.
